

Immunization Requirements

IS YOUR CHILD READY FOR 7TH GRADE?

DID YOU KNOW...

...the Pennsylvania Department of Health requires all children entering 7th grade submit the required proof of vaccinations prior to school attendance or they will not be able to attend school? It's the law.



Follow these steps to make sure your child is ready for school.



SCHEDULE

bring your child a well visit to ensure they receive the required 7th grade vaccinations:

- Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis)—1 dose
- Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV4)—1 dose



OBTAIN

a medical certificate signed by your child's doctor, detailing the plan to complete vaccines **if the next dose is not medically appropriate.**

SUBMIT

documentation **if your child is exempt from any immunization(s)** for a medical, religious or philosophical/strong moral reason. If your child is exempt he or she may be removed from school during an outbreak.
